

MTR Recognised as Global Sustainability Leader by Two Major Indexes

Two major global indexes on corporate sustainability have once again recognised the MTR Corporation as one of the world's leaders in corporate governance, risk management, environmental reporting, occupational health & safety and human capital development.

The Dow Jones Sustainability World Index (DJSI World) continues to rank the MTR Corporation number one in Corporate Sustainability within the global "Travel and Tourism" sector. The Corporation qualified for the index for the eighth consecutive year, and continues to be the only Hong Kong company to make the list. The Corporation also retains its inclusion in the Dow Jones Sustainability Asia Pacific Index (DJSI Asia/Pacific).

"Sustainability is not merely a corporate goal at the MTR, but is embedded in our DNA," said Dr Glenn Frommer, Head of Sustainability Development of the MTR Corporation. "Our continual inclusion in these indices is recognition of how we have woven the values of long-term sustainability and responsible corporate governance into our overall business practices."

In total, more than 2,500 global companies in all sectors were assessed on corporate economic, environmental and social performance.
